- Engaged fulfillment of three-year board term (up to two terms).
- Focused participation in committee work and 12 board meetings a year (typically totaling approximately 2-4 hours per month).
- Enthusiastic participation in fundraising.
- Ambassadorship on behalf of the organization: promoting its efforts and continually cultivating and stewarding networks.

Experience/Qualifications:

DAP seeks candidates who value social and racial justice and the transformative power of trauma-informed care in healing families affected by domestic violence. Candidates will be results-oriented and driven advocates towards ending intimate partner violence. They will excel in relationship building, organization, and working with others. They are successful high-level strategic planners. Prior board or planning/steering-committee experience a plus, but not required. Young professionals, BIPOC, people with disabilities, and/or people identifying as LGBTQIA are strongly encouraged to apply. This is a volunteer position.
